I. Risk of COVID-19 Exposure.

II. Summer Program COVID-19 Specific Rules & Guidelines.

-Campers will need to certify that no one at their home, including the camper, or come in contact with, has shown signs or symptoms of any illness in the past 2 weeks or has tested positive for COVID-19.

-We will be requiring masks to be worn by all staff, volunteers and campers and practice and enforce social distancing.

-We MAY require all campers to get tested the week before camp starts and our staff WILL take their temperature each camp day. Camper must be below 100 degrees.

-Campers must bring ample water, snacks, and food for the camp day and no sharing will be allowed. We will have a water refill station that will be facilitated by our staff and volunteers with disinfecting protocol.

-We will have available sanitizer and a bathroom that will be disinfected each camp day prior to the start of camp that day.

IN-PERSON SHIFT TO ZOOM RISK:

In the event that we have another government shut down before the date camp starts or during the two weeks - We will shorten the play length or modify the material and move to online camp with less hours to minimize student screen time. Our schedule would transition to everything ON ZOOM meeting daily from 2-3 hours each day. Camp cost would then be reduced partially and we will provide that refund.
